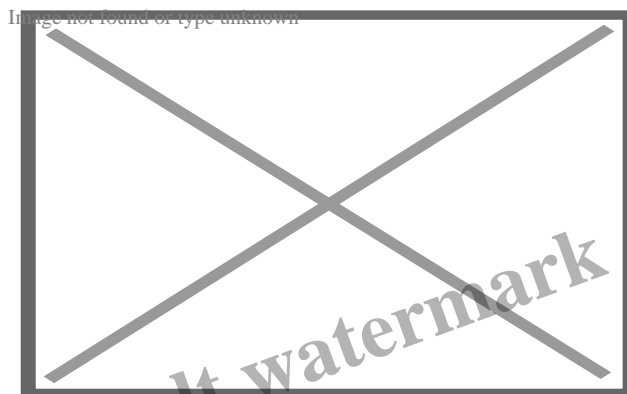

Very, Very &&&&&"Lexable...&&&&&"
